Dear Parent/Carer

I am delighted to inform you that your daughter has been accepted on the Level 2/3 NVQ in Beauty Therapy in our sixth form.

Students who will be studying Beauty Therapy in September will need to purchase a compulsory kit. The kit consists of the following:-

- 1 navy blue tunic, 1 navy pair of blue trousers
- 1 large and 1 small kit bag
- Full wax kit (including wax heater, wax strips, spatulas, pre-wax, post-wax, and wax equipment cleaner)
- Hand lotion
- Pack of nail files
- Pack of orangewood sticks
- OPI white nail polish
- OPI red polish
- Cotton discs
- Cuticle hoof stick
- Cuticle nippers
- Nurses scissors
- Small scissors
- Slant tweezers
- Tinting set (including dampen dish, tint brush, eyelash comb, black, blue, and brown tint, tint developer)
- Makeup kit (including light, fair and medium foundation, contour corrector palette, finishing powder, 2 blushes, eyeshadow compact, mascara, make up brush belt, makeup brushes for face).

The health and safety guidance for hair and beauty specifies that students must wear their tunic for practical sessions and bring their equipment to every lesson. They must wear flat, black, closed toe shoes, and black socks.

Adhering to health and safety legislation, jewellery is not to be worn - including facial piercings – and make-up must also be kept to a minimum and hair tied up, completely off the face.

Our preferred method of payment is ParentPay. The total cost of the kit is £300. (Cheques will be accepted and should be made payable to Heanor Gate Science College). A deposit of £50 must be made by the end of September 2017. Full payment should be made by June 2018.
