Off the back of another successful residential, I would like to take the opportunity to thank you for your continuous support throughout the GCSE PE course. This year's Year 11s are on course to achieve an excellent set of results this summer and, whilst they have all worked extremely hard, this would not be possible without the encouragement and support they receive from home. I am already looking forward to seeing a large number of them returning to study PE in the Sixth Form.

In order to ensure they are fully prepared for their final exams, each student will receive an hour of 1-1 tuition based on their recent mock results, as well as further opportunities for paired revision from Monday 30 April 2018 to Thursday 17 May 2018, prior to their two PE exams. As always, students can sign up for these sessions based on their own preference and other commitments. In addition to this, there will be a coursework session on Friday 16 February 2018 and a further session on Friday 2 March 2018, which is their deadline for completion.
