Welcome to the first edition of our termly PEPA newsletter. This newsletter aims to keep you fully updated with all the happenings in PE and Performing Arts. In this term's edition you will find out about the success of our students at both GCSE and A-Level, along with students' achievements at Sports Awards Evening.



Students once again did themselves proud in PE with excellent results in both Key Stage 4 & 5. 98% of our 49 GCSE students achieved a grade A*-C and 48% achieved a grade A*- A.

Students undertaking BTEC PE also achieved excellent results with students achieving 100% A*-C.

Special mention must be given to Sophie Meakin, Toby Green, Bevan Hobson and Matt Cross who all achieved grade A* at GCSE and Lauren Barker who was awarded a Distinction* in BTEC Sport.

Students also did extremely well in PE at KS5 with excellent results again at both A-level and BTEC. Students at Heanor Gate achieved 83.3% A*-C at A-level and 66.7 A* -B at AS. This equates to almost 2 whole grades better than national averages in PE, another remarkable achievement. All of our Y13 students enlisted in the universities of their choice, many of them choosing to study sport.
