Dear Parent/Carer

The Year 11 students continue to work hard both in exams and study sessions, with many opting to study with us outside of normal school hours. We hope that this dedication is rewarded in the summer when their results arrive.

On **Thursday 14 June** arrangements for Year 11 students have changed slightly, they are also different depending on what subjects they are studying:

Students studying **Spanish**:

- Students arrive for school at normal time, register with their tutor, and follow the normal exam arrangements for the morning.
- Afterwards students may leave the school site but must be back for 12.55.

Students studying **food or resistant materials**:

- Students arrive for school at normal time and register with their tutor.
- Period 1 they go to physics revision. Period 2 and 3 they go to either food or resistant materials revision in preparation for their afternoon examination.

Students studying **German**:

- Students arrive for school at normal time and register with their tutor.
- Periods 1-3 they go to German revision.

Students who do not study Spanish, food or resistant materials:

- Students need to be on site and in physics revision lessons by 12.55.

All Year 11 students are welcome to have lunch on the school site but do not have to.

We would ask you to remind your son/daughter of the importance of focus and attention during these revision periods and the need to continue to set the standard for all other year groups.

Could I also ask that if your son/daughter has any uniform which will no longer be required, particularly ties and blazers, that they bring it to Mrs Coleman or me in the Year 11 Achievement Office in D Block before they leave.

Our Year 11 students have made us all immensely proud, in particular over the last few weeks. I have seen students both support each other and push themselves beyond what they thought possible just a few months ago. I would like to thank them publically for everything they have done and we look forward to celebrating with them after the exams have finished.
