Creating a mind map

Produce a mind map that is creative, engaging and visually stimulating. Your mind map should explore your chosen starting point in its entirety. Show that you are considering the many different creative journeys that your chosen starting point could possibly take you on - keep your mind open!

- Before you begin -consider the general styling, font and colour scheme of your mind map. Will it be hand written or will the text be typed up and printed off the computer or a mixture of both?
- Present the title of your chosen starting point so that it is a clear and dominant feature of your mind map. Will it be central, enlarged, a contrasting font or colour, etc?
- Your mind map should be a combination of text and imagery.
- Your mind map **must** show that you have considered relevant links to the work of artists, art movements and/or the art of other cultures. How will you achieve this through your chosen starting point?
