### Club Correze

We are delighted to be able to offer Year 8 students the opportunity to participate in a residential, multi-activity trip to Club Correze, in the Dordogne region of France. Club Correze is a specialist multi-activity centre which offers adventure holidays for school groups. You may wish to view their website at <http://www.clubcorreze.com>

We will leave school on **Friday 26 May 2017 and return on Saturday 3 June 2017**. Brief details of the trip can be found on the attached information sheet. In previous years we have had well over 40 students participate and we are confident that this trip will be very popular again. The total cost is dependent on the number of students who participate in the trip and is as follows:

- 30 - 35 students, total cost of £582.00
- 35 - 40 students, total cost of £562.50
- 41+ students, total cost of £537.00

The accommodation block sleeps a maximum of 50 students split equally, male/female. Places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis upon receipt of an initial £75 deposit. In the event of demand for places exceeding supply we will open a reserve list. Please note, the school does not require payment in full until March 2017 and it is quite acceptable to make regular contributions towards the total cost over the next few months. Club Correze is ABTA bonded through a large sport tour operator. The school is required to make staged payments over the next few months so it will be necessary to ask parents to meet the payment schedule on time. Full travel and baggage insurance is included in the price so inability to participate in the trip on medical grounds is covered; subject to the terms and conditions of the insurance policy. The price also includes a Club Correze personalised polo shirt.

We understand many parents may have questions to ask about this trip. Therefore, we will be holding a parents' evening on Wednesday 19 October 2016 from 6.00pm until 7.00pm, during which time we will show pictures from our previous trips to the centre, and talk you through a typical trip, answering any questions you may have.

We will be accepting deposits for the trip after the parents' evening. **At that time, if you wish to pay online, please visit ParentPay and go to your child's account** or, if you wish to pay by cheque, students will be able to collect a letter from Student Reception.

Please note, the school reserves the right to refuse permission for any student to attend the trip if his/her behaviour at school is thought unacceptable for a trip of this nature.
