As you will be aware Tuesday 11 July is our final Immersion Day of the year. Year 9 students will be taking part in workshops in the morning relating to 'Health and Wellbeing and Tolerance in Society' and then they will participate in Sports Day in the afternoon.

We plan to show "Murdered for Being Different" which tells the story of a teenager who was beaten up and murdered for being different. The film does contain some swearing and violence however, we feel that the issue is important enough to justify showing the film.

Murdered for Being Different is available to watch on iPlayer if you would like to watch the film yourself before the Immersion Day.

As this video deals with difficult subject material, should you wish your son or daughter not to participate in this session, please contact Miss Lee or Mrs Wainwright and alternative activities can be arranged.
