

YEAR 11 hair & beauty coursework expectations:

Research project

For this project, students have to carry out a research project about the safety of hair or beauty services. They have to write a specific research proposal and outline the area of their project. Students then produce a PowerPoint highlighting their research, aiming to prove or disprove their proposal.

This could include YouTube, magazine articles, textbooks and industry journals. You should ensure that you log all resources on your research log. Design brief project

For this project, students have to design the hair, nails, make-up and hair accessories for an event of their choice. As the Y11s have their prom next year, the suggested event is going to be PROM.

DEADLINE: Friday, 1st December 2017

ALL the written information consisting of:

Learning outcome 1 (Understand how to analyse hair and beauty design briefs)

Learning outcome 2 (Be able to develop and present design ideas for a hair and beauty brief)

Evaluation of design brief

Design brief mood board

Students will be provided with cardboard to produce their mood board on, however students may wish to purchase an A3 canvas for the project.



Tips for students: you should be doing a **minimum** of **1 hour / week homework**. Homework for this unit will be gathering resources to use on their mood boards. This should include a range of 3D and colourful images and textures from at least 2 different sources (such as magazines, newspapers, the internet, drawings, YouTube clips/music videos or film, television and theatre).
