
Little's 466 School Bus

As we prepare for the start of the new academic year we wanted to inform you about the way in which Little's will be operating their 466 bus route from September.

To accommodate for the staggered start and finish times for all year groups in school, we have arranged for the school bus to temporarily collect students at the end of the day at a later time of **3.15pm**. The collection times in the morning will remain the same as before as they allow for all students to arrive on site before their allocated start time. An amended timetable has been supplied on the next page.

School Bus Guidelines

- It is mandatory for face masks to be worn whilst travelling on public transport. This also applies to the school bus. Please ensure you have supplied your child with a suitable mask or face covering or transport may be refused.
- Students should sit in proximity to those within their year group bubble, and use the same seats as much as possible. The suggested seating arrangements from Derbyshire County Council are as follows;



- Students should pay using **exact money** for each journey as change will not be given in order to minimise the handling of cash by the driver. Each one-way journey costs £1.50.
- Each student should ensure they practise safe hygiene by thoroughly washing their hands or using an alternative method such as hand sanitiser before every journey.

Whilst I do not envisage there being any issues with these guidelines being followed, any issues caused by students not doing so will be dealt with appropriately.
