Dear Parent/Carer

We have been informed of a further confirmed positive case of COVID-19 this morning. The student (Year 12) in question last attended school on Thursday 15 October 2020. The student started to show symptoms on Friday 16 October and received a positive test result on Sunday 18 October. After consultation with Public Health England we have been advised that anyone who was in “close contact” with the student up to 48hrs prior to the student showing symptoms will need to self-isolate for 14 days. As a result the Y12 Hair and Beauty students will be required to self-isolate until Wednesday 28 October.

From information gathered from the students/families themselves, no other students outside of this group have been in “close contact” and therefore no further students need be affected, however, if you have specific concerns contact your child’s Assistant Achievement Leader

You should arrange for testing if you develop symptoms of COVID-19. The most important symptoms are:

- a new continuous cough
- a high temperature
- a loss of, or change in, your normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia).

As always our thoughts are with the student and their family and we wish them a speedy recovery.

As I have stated previously this will be an ongoing situation and I thank everyone for their support and understanding as we continue to respond to these challenging circumstances.
