## November Mock Timetable

An overview of the mock timetable is on the reverse of this information, with the main features outlined below:

- Whilst the main examination period is two weeks, you will notice that it actually spans over four weeks with one examination on Friday 13 November and the final exam being on Monday 30 November.
- The major difference for the two main weeks are the changes in the school start and finish times. The starting times differ to ensure the first set of examinations are finished by 10:00am and the end time is 1:00pm every day for this two week period. Starting the examinations early mean that the year group will be able to remain in their bubble and sit all of the examinations required during this time.
- During the mock examination periods, when students are not in examinations they will be in revision lessons for future exams or coursework sessions.
- 27 November is the Sixth Form Taster Day, more information about this is being discussed at school and separate communication regarding this matter will be communicated to parents.
- Over half term, students need to find a balance between resting and beginning to plan for the forthcoming mocks. Students have begun learning about how to revise as part of the tutor programme and now is the perfect opportunity to put some of those newly learnt skills into action.

This information provides an overview of the mock exam period. Please take time over half-term to discuss this with your son/daughter and highlight all of the exam periods that apply to them. After half-term students will also receive a more detailed timetable as to how they will be spending each period of time whilst on the school site over the mock period, this information will be shared on the second week back after half-term.
