Dear Parent/Carer

We would like to offer your child the opportunity to participate in a trip to The National Holocaust Centre and Museum on Thursday 24 June 2021. This trip will include an educator led programme designed for students, which considers the choices made by ordinary people and to what extent it contributed to the Holocaust. The programme will develop students' knowledge of events of the Holocaust and their awareness of the causes and complexities of it.

During the programme the students will visit the Holocaust exhibition, the memorial gardens and participate in a workshop exploring 'choices.' There is also a unique experience for students to listen to the testimony of a survivor and ask them questions.

Due to the nature of this trip, our expectation of students' behaviour when visiting the centre is incredibly high. We will be looking at a topic which has far reaching consequences and we expect the students to represent the school with their best behaviour.

Students will need to wear their full school uniform, arrive promptly to school at the usual time and go to their tutor base to register. We will be leaving school at 9.15am and will return for 2.55pm. Students will also need a packed lunch for the day. Please be aware that we have students who may be participating in this trip who have a serious nut allergy. **Please avoid giving your son/daughter bagged nuts or products with a nut content**, as even the smell can cause these students anxiety. If your child is entitled to free school meals and requires a packed lunch on the day, please order one via ParentPay.

The cost of the trip, including transport and entrance, is £15 per student. Please logon to your child's ParentPay account to give your consent and make payment. If you require a PayPoint barcode please contact the school as soon as possible.
